

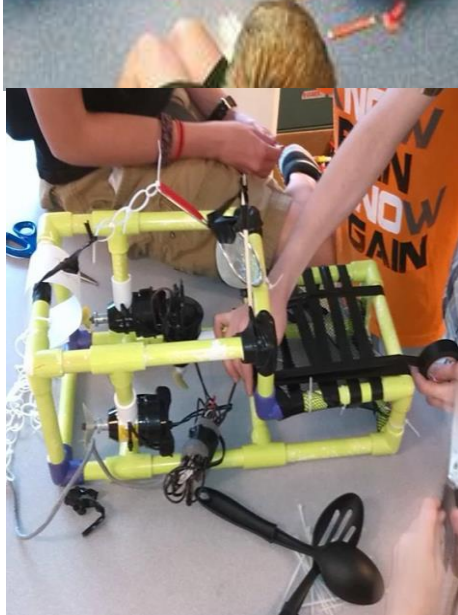

Underwater Remotely Operated Vehicle (ROV) Building for the Classroom

Interested in marine technology, underwater robotics or student competitions?

Come meet C4OE Director, Erica Moulton for a short, hands-on professional development at the Hartford Boat Show. We promise to get your hands wet, but not dirty and answer all of your questions about incorporating what you learn into your own classroom or afterschool clubs.

Overview

Excite students about the world of ocean exploration and ROVs. Using simple, affordable materials, teachers will design, build, and test their own underwater vehicle and receive information on how to use ROVs to teach about ocean exploration, technology, and basic physical science concepts. The workshop is geared to teachers of grades 6-12, College, and informal educators. Teachers must register in advance. The workshop is FREE, but space is limited.

Participants will:

- Be introduced to ROV programs and learn about the small scale ROVs that can be replicated with students
- Acquire the knowledge, skills, and resources to become a mentor for students in designing and building an ROV at their own school
- Learn how other teachers are integrating ROVs into their classroom/curriculum, and
- Make connections with educators with similar interests and share "best practices" in teaching and Instruction.
